FEBRUARY VACATION CAMP 2010

Class Descriptions:

Clay Dragons: Using self hardening clay, students will sculpt dragons and then add details with a variety of mixed media materials.

Name Tag Pendants: Students will explore aspects of metalsmithing as they construct pendants using the letters of their name. Students will begin their exploration by learning proper and safe techniques for cutting sheet metal and stamping letters and forms into the surface of their pendant. Students will finish their exploration into metalsmithing by sanding and polishing their pendant before linking it onto a silken cord with a jump ring.

Pottery Wheel: Learn to throw pots on the potter's wheel. Experienced instructors will demonstrate throwing techniques and assist students individually. We will pick the best piece and paint them to create a lasting memory. Pottery will be made out of self hardening clay. Pots made in this class are NOT FOOD SAFE.

Rings of Silver: Create your own sterling silver ring! Use metalsmithing equipment and learn how to solder. Great metalsmithing class. Ages 8 and up. Cost for this class is \$20.

Beaded Earring & Necklace Set: Kids will learn the art of beaded jewelry. Through design and instruction, students will create a matching set of one of a kind jewelry.

Clay Bugs: Using self hardening clay, students will learn to sculpt a variety of clay bugs. They will embellish them with wire legs, wings and antennae.

Sea Sculptures: Sculpt starfish, octopus, fish & more out of clay! Learn about texture, size, patterns and the creatures from the sea.

Bangle Bracelets: Silver, copper and brass will be used in a variety of combinations and patterns to create bangle bracelets.

Clay Robots: Using self hardening clay, students will design and sculpt their very own robot! A variety of mixed media materials will be used to bring the robots to life and embellish their distinct features.

Enamel Pendant: Learn to make enamel copper jewelry. With help from the instructor, students will choose their designs and create colorful enamel pieces that will then be turned into wearable art.

Artistic play stations will be set up for energetic kids who finish projects early.

Lunch is from 12-12:30. Campers should bring lunch and snacks. No glass in the studio please.

Workshops: \$13 each, 5 or more workshops: \$12 each, A Full Day for \$60 (does not include Rings of Silver, which is \$20)
