April VACATION CAMP 2019: Class Descriptions

Pottery Wheel: Learn how to throw pots on the potter's wheel. Experienced instructors will demonstrate throwing techniques and assist students individually.

Pet Bowl : Campers will create a handbuilt dish for their pet or little critter.

Pinchpot Monsters: Learn how to create a pinchpot and then turn it into a unique silly or scary monster !

Fairy Houses: Build a fairy house using natural materials to create a whimsical dwelling that will be perfect for any fairy !

Coilpot bowl: Create a swirly bowl made out of coils. Learn how to join coils together for a unique design.

Flower Pots: Spring is finally here ! Lets create a handbuilt flower pot to enjoy a beautiful plant in.

Flower Vases: Using extruded forms lets create some unique and playful vases to hold a lovely bouquet of flowers.

Rings of Silver: Create your own sterling silver ring! Use metalsmithing equipment and learn how to form and solder. Cost for this class \$20. **(Ages 8 and up)**

Glass Pendants: Students will work to create pendants from colored glass. In this workshop we will cover glass cutting, assembling pieces which will then be fused in our kiln. The campers pendant will be available for pickup within a week. Cost for this class is \$20. **(Ages 8 and up)**

Glass Bugs: Students will work with colored glass and assemble pieces together to create a bug. Learn how to cut and stack the glass which will then be fused in our kiln. The bugs will be available for pick up within a week. **(Ages 8 and up)**

Print Making: Students will learn simple printmaking techniques, such as monoprinting and techniques that can be used with clay.
